Spaying or Neutering is Good for You and Your Pet!

- Sterilized pets live longer, healthier lives.
- Sterilized pets make better, more affectionate companions, and are less likely to roam or fight.
- Sterilized cats are less likely to spray and mark territory.
- Unsterilized animals exhibit more behavior problems, and may be more likely to bite. Females in heat often cry incessantly and attract unwanted males.
- Sterilization reduces pet overpopulation and the number of unwanted animals killed in our animal shelters 300,000 in North Carolina in 2006 alone!
